Instructions for the Month of September

Innerwear:

It is compulsory for students to wear innerwear. If a student arrives without innerwear, a fine of Rs. 50 will be charged.

PT Uniform:

The PT uniform must be worn on designated PT uniform days. Failure to do so will also result in a Rs. 50 fine.

Parents, please understand that these fines are necessary. Remarks from teachers are often overlooked, and children do not take the rules seriously. However, when a monetary fine is involved, we see a significant improvement in compliance. Since we started implementing these fines, we've noticed better adherence to the PT uniform and innerwear rules.
